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**ORDER:**

1. With reference to the G.O. first cited the Committee was constituted for fixation of fee in respect of Self-Financing Colleges under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Mr. Justice K. Venkataraman.

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2. The Secretary, Fees Fixation Committee, Chennai – 600 025 received a letter dated 01.08.2023 from St. John's College of Medical Sciences, Vellore District to fix the fee for the three Allied Health Science Courses, namely;

S. No.	Name of the Course
1.	B.Sc., Accident and Emergency care technology
2.	B.Sc., Dialysis Technology
3.	B.Sc., Radiography & Imaging Technology

And to add the college name to the DME web portal and Seat Matrix list for conducting counselling. The said letter is forwarded to the Committee.

3. The Committee verified the Expenditure Statement based on the 20 Major heads namely Salaries and allowances including TF (Teaching, Non-Teaching and Administration), Welfare Expenses, Electricity Charges, Telephone, Postage & Internet, Equipment Purchase, Books & Periodicals, Printing & Stationery, Consumable, Research and Development, University affiliation fees and Inspection Charges, Sports, Games, Meetings and Functions, Awards, Merit Scholarship, Travelling and Conveyance, Repairs and Maintenance, Depreciation, Advertisement and Miscellaneous Expenditure. A detailed report was made covering all these aspects and was analysed by the Committee.
4. The following seat sharing for admission of students is already in vogue for several years for BHMS., BSMS., etc., Therefore same sharing is applicable to the courses referred to above.

### **ORDER:**

1. The Committee fixed the following fees all including Tuition fee, Admission fee, Special fee, Laboratory / Computer / Internet fee, Library fee, Sports fee, Maintenance and Amenities fees, extracurricular activities fee, and other recurring expenditure.



1.	B.Sc., Accident and Emergency care technology	Rs.50,000/-
2.	B.Sc., Dialysis Technology	Rs.50,000/-
3.	B.Sc., Radiography & Imaging Technology	Rs.50,000/-

2. In addition to the above recurring annual fee, the concerned institutions are permitted to collect a development fee not exceeding Rs.5,000/- per student.
3. If the institution seek revision of the fee fixed, it is always open to the said institution to apply for revision of fee to the committee along with the relevant records and book of accounts to the Committee.
4. The Management is directed to cover all the Students under Students Group Insurance Scheme.


5. The above fees does not include Hostel, Transport, Mess charges etc.,
6. The Committee directs that the institutions shall not collect or levy any other recurring or non-recurring fee including capitation fee.
7. Any deviation of the proceedings will entail the institution to undergo serious penal consequences like withdrawal of approval by respective authorities and disaffiliation by the concerned University as well as imposition of fine.
